### KEY PROGRAMS UPDATE

#### ALPHONSO SUMMER LITERACY CAMP PILOT PROGRAM

Last year ASF begun the work of restructuring its programs to a more sustainable framework. Our goal was to consolidate our initial activities under the Alphonso Summer Literacy Camp. By doing this, we would allow ASF to have a much more significant impact on the lives of students and gain a larger return on investments in the program model.

Alphonso continues in its relationship with Cassava River Primary and Infant School as the host of this pilot program. Together and with the support of a work group, we have completed the development of the curriculum that will be utilized for the literacy camp. At this time, our focus is fundraising to support the facilitation of the program. We anticipate that the program will cost an approximate total of \$10, 715. Funding will cover the costs for enrolled students including materials, meals, and extracurricular activities as well as program materials and stipends for volunteers.

While ASF fundraise to launch Alphonso Summer Literacy Camp, we will continue awarding scholarships to graduating students from Cassava River Primary and Infant school. This year, we celebrated nine students who each received scholarships to cover the cost of enrollment into secondary school!

An eight-week intensive and enrichment reading curriculum featuring social-emotional learning (SEL) components for students. Scholarships are awarded to students to help cover the costs associated with transitioning from primary school. 

The below data depicts the fiscal activities of Alphonso Scholarship Fund, Inc. for the 2023-24 fiscal year.




Income breakdown percentages by funding sources
